- ◉ Supply of medicines
- ◉ Accommodation as per status
- ◉ Services of nurse or special para medical staff

- Free of charge MA by AMA
- Reimbursement of expenses done.
- MA of families
- At Hospital, Residence or at consulting room of AMA

TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES

- Patient falls ill is not the headquarters of the AMA
- Certificate of AMA

- ◉ Reference of AMA
- ◉ Treatment to be taken in Govt. Hospital
- ◉ Can be referred to other hospital by AMA
- ◉ Special Nursing
- ◉ Treatment at residence
- ◉ Injuries due to civil disturbance
- ◉ Saving clause

UN APPROVED HOSPITAL

| Item | Reimbursement |
|-------------------|---|
| Drugs & Medicines | 50% of reimbursible drugs |
| Investigation | As per approved rates otherwise 50% of actual |
| OT Charges | 40% max 3000/- |
| Anesthesia | 40% max 3000/- |
| Doctor fees | 40% max 3000/- |
| Room charges | As per approved rates |
| Blood bank | 75% of approved rates |
| Dialysis | 75% of approved rates |
